### What you will be doing:

This role is a wonderful opportunity for anyone interested in Art Therapy. The Advocacy Council is a group of self-advocates who live or study in Horizons. They speak up for their community, protect people's rights, promote fairness and help make sure everyone feels listened to, respected and included. They meet monthly. We would like an artist to capture the key themes and voices from this meeting by producing a piece of art with a person we support.

- You'll receive a copy of the written minutes from each monthly Advocacy Council meeting.
- You'll work alongside a self-advocate to interpret the minutes creatively.
- You'll work with this person to create 1 piece of artwork each month that captures the key themes and voices from the meeting.
- The artwork will need to be accessible and engaging, reflecting the experiences and perspectives of the Council.
- The artwork will be part of an annual showcase where all the pieces are presented to the Executive Team, highlighting the Council's work in a creative way.

### What you'll gain:

- Gain experience working alongside people with lived experience of disability and advocacy.
- Use and develop creative skills by turning monthly meeting notes into engaging artwork.
- Contribute to a unique and inclusive way of communicating the Advocacy Council's impact.
- Build friendships and connections within Horizons.
- Make a real difference to the quality of life of people by ensuring their voices are heard and celebrated.
- Be part of a presentation to the Executive Team, influencing how the organisation understands and values advocacy.

### What you need:

Experience as an Artist or Art Therapist would be ideal. A talent for art, an interest in human rights and a creative spirit.
